This is a project for integral value-based education from an intercultural and international perspective, blending the best from the Indian/ Buddhist educational traditions and European/ Western education, and creating a new generation of international schools. It is expounded in detail through **an illustrated 1200 pages book in 3 volumes with bibliography, a parallel set of illustrated books centred on topics or disciplines, a parallel set of academic books, and various handbooks and shorter materials. Parts of it have been published as scholarly articles in international journals. Legally registered** at the Government of India and the Government of Catalonia as copyright.

The elaboration and launching of the Project towards investors/ public administrations has evolved within two trusts from Andhra Pradesh (South India) with funds provided by a donation through a trust in the USA. **(2012-2015).**

In a second phase (from 2019 till now), the process towards materialization has continued with the support of a third trust and various social agents and personalities from India.

The Project has been finally presented to the Prime Minister and the Government of India; it has also been presented to the Education Minister and the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, amongst other personalities of India (regional and national parliamentarians and ministers, entrepreneurs, etc).

It has been published at the web-site of Fundacion Phi (Spain) which officially supports it: university campus for consciousness studies with funds from the European Union/ accredited as a campus of academic excellence.
